Hamlet - Opening battlement scene - Act I scene i - Francisco, Bernardo, Horatio, Marcellus, Ghost

*Henry IV Part 1* - Act II sc iv – Falstaff, Gadshill, Bardolph, Peto, Francis, Poins & Prince Henry )From enter Falstaff to enter Hostess)

Henry VI Part 2 – Jack Cade's Rebellion - Act IV scene ii – George Bevis, John Holland, Jack Cade,

Dick the Butcher, Smith the Weaver, Michael, Clerk, William Stafford, a Sawyer and 'infinite others'

Henry VI Part 3 - Deer chase - Act III scene i - King Henry & two Keepers

King Richard II - Act III scene iv - Queen, 2 Ladies, Servant, Gardener

Measure for Measure – Act II scene iv – Angelo & Isabella (from enter Isabella)

The Merchant of Venice - Portia's Failed Suitors - Act I sc ii, Portia and Nerissa (and Servant)

The Merchant of Venice - Jessica's Farewell - Act II sc vi, Shylock, Jessica and Launcelot

Richard II - Act III scene iv - Queen, 2 Ladies, Servant, Gardener

The Tempest - Act II sc ii- Caliban's New Master's- Caliban, Trinculo and Stephano

Hamlet - Hamlet & Father's Ghost scenes - Act I scene iv & v - Hamlet, Horatio, Marcellus, Ghost
