SHAKESPEARE GLOBE CENTRE NEW ZEALAND YOUNG SHAKESPEARE COMPANY TOUR ESCORT APPLICATION 2019

If you are wishing to gain professional development and enjoy being with and managing teenagers, being one of the two Tour Escorts of Shakespeare Globe Centre NZ Young Shakespeare Company (SGCNZ YSC) provides you a wealth of experiences. Ideal for a teacher or actor/director/Shakespeare devotee, this opportunity to be able to sit in at the Globe on Workshops and Rehearsals to learn and hone your own skills and knowledge, while supervising these highly talented young people, is extremely valuable.

Each year a group is selected from SGCNZ's Regional and National University of Otago Sheilah Winn Shakespeare Festivals to attend our National Shakespeare Schools Production week. From this group, twenty-four students between 16 and 19 years of age are chosen to represent NZ and travel to London and Stratford-Upon-Avon as the SGCNZ YSC. The trip is for nearly three weeks, coinciding with mid-year secondary school holidays. In 2019 this will be from Friday 5 July to Wednesday 24 July. (The troupe depart from Heathrow to return on Monday 22 July - if staying on, it is essential that you accompany them to Heathrow. There are stop-offs on the way there - part of the trip!)

The Tour Escorts - one male and one female - are responsible for the on-site management of the tour, following the instructions as produced by Mr Kerry Maher of Maher Escorted Tours in association with Dawn Sanders. This includes travelling over and back with the group, living in with them at Bankside House, organising daily Company meetings, workshops and line learning (as is possible within other duties), ensuring the members of the group are at the right place at the right time, distribution of tickets, tending to the pastoral care, general needs and supervision. A more detailed list of duties will be supplied to the successful applicants.

All bookings must be made via our agent, Kerry Maher in order to obtain the discounted prices for the whole group. Over half of the air fares, accommodation, dinner & breakfasts, tickets and other fixed costs will be paid for. This will leave a balance to be paid for by each Tour Escort of approx \$2750 plus personal expenses – a total of approximately \$3700 each.

Qualities required are experience with teenagers, organisational skills, interpersonal skills, patience, enthusiasm, a sense of humour and a passion for Shakespeare and theatre!

Successful applicants must be Friends of SGCNZ and be knowledgeable about our activities.
