SGCNZ/Ida Gaskin Shakespeare Essay Competition with English at Otago

"Devise, wit; write, pen; for I am for whole volumes in folio." – Love's Labour's Lost

Entries are invited in an essay competition: Options 1 and 2 are directed to Year 13 students in 2018 and 2019 (though younger ones may enter); Option 3 is for only Year 7-10s.

BRIEF

Choose ONE of the three options:

1. Submit an essay on a Shakespeare topic of your choice. Length - up to 2000 words.

OR

2. "The endings of Shakespeare's plays raise more questions than they resolve." You should discuss at least two plays in your essay. Length - 1500 to 2000 words.

OR

3. **Year 7 – 10 students only.** Write a short story incorporating at least 20 phrases from Shakespeare's plays, poems or sonnets. Length 300–400 words.

Please note:

- Readers will be looking for well-written essays that show evidence of independent thought and originality
- Spelling must be accurate
- Essays will be read "blind"; please do not identify your name or your school on the essay itself
- Ensure that you do send your form with your entry
- Entrants must be a Friend of SGCNZ either through their school or individually.

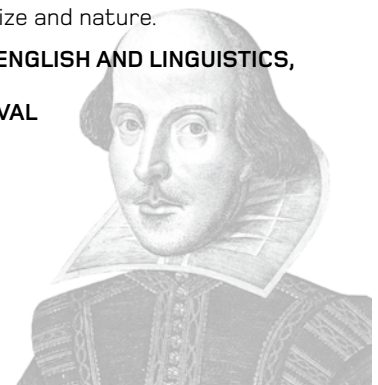
