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## **SGCNZ Shakespeare Ora Aotearoa**

**18-19 July 2020**

Shakespeare Ora Aotearoa is a one-off event, with support of the Ministry of Youth Development, for young people between 15 and 24 years old. Thirty participants will be selected. All will be required to choose a Shakespeare character, bring a few of that person's lines, and a mental health, social or environmental issue. With guidance and mentoring, the intent over the course of this free residential weekend is for each of the 6 groups of 5 participants to write a 5-10 minute play, embracing the characters and issues the group brings. These will be filmed and, potentially made available for schools, to stimulate discussion on issues, or be performed as short plays for similar purposes, or even be expandable into longer plays or films. The event will begin at 10am on Saturday 18 July and conclude after a showing at 5pm on Sunday 19 July. The costs of accommodation, food and all sessions will be covered by SGCNZ.
