Compositions may be no longer than 3 minutes

Compositions can be inspired by any Shakespeare play or poem

Any students at secondary school, home schooled, or community groups from Year 7-13, under 20 years of age are eligible to enter

All spelling must be accurate

Entrants must be a Friend of SGCNZ either through their school, home school cluster OR community groups, OR individually



A first, second and third place winner will be chosen for Category A and Category B for the above prizes given in each category.

A Supreme Winner will be chosen and receive a further prize of \$500

 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{NB}}\xspace$ The value of the prizes may vary depending on the entries and the judges decisions.

Prize winners will be announced at SGCNZ's VUW National Shakespeare Festival Award Ceremony at 7.00pm, 31 May 2026 at the St James Theatre in Wellington.

The finalists might have a chance to attend workshops at SGCNZ VUW National Shakespeare Festival free-of-charge on 29 May in Wellington.

The Supreme Winner, or if not available, another winner will be offered the position of Student Composer at SGCNZ's National Shakespeare Schools Production, 26 September - 4 October 2026 in Wellington and also be considered for selection as a member of the SGCNZ YSC 2027 travelling to the Globe in London.
