 - why you have chosen the play for which you are creating the static image.
 - why you are using the reflected style in your image
 - the target audience to whom you are directing the design
- 2 Send with the attached entry form by 27th March 2026

Any students at secondary school, home schooled, or community groups from Year 7-13, under 20 years of age are eligible to enter

All spelling must be accurate

Entrants must be a Friend of SGCNZ either through their school, home school cluster OR community groups, OR individually

The SGCNZ/ Adam Foundation Static Image Competition and the SGCNZ/ Adam Foundation Poster Competition are two separate Competitions.

Both can be entered at the same time, with appropriate different designs and inclusions

NB: The value of the prizes may vary depending on the entries and the judges decisions. A first, second and third place winner will be chosen



Prize winners will be announced at SGCNZ's VUW National Shakespeare Festival Award Ceremony at 7.00pm, 31 May 2026 at the St James Theatre in Wellington.

The winning designs may be displayed at the National Festival and will then be displayed in Shakespeare's Glo
