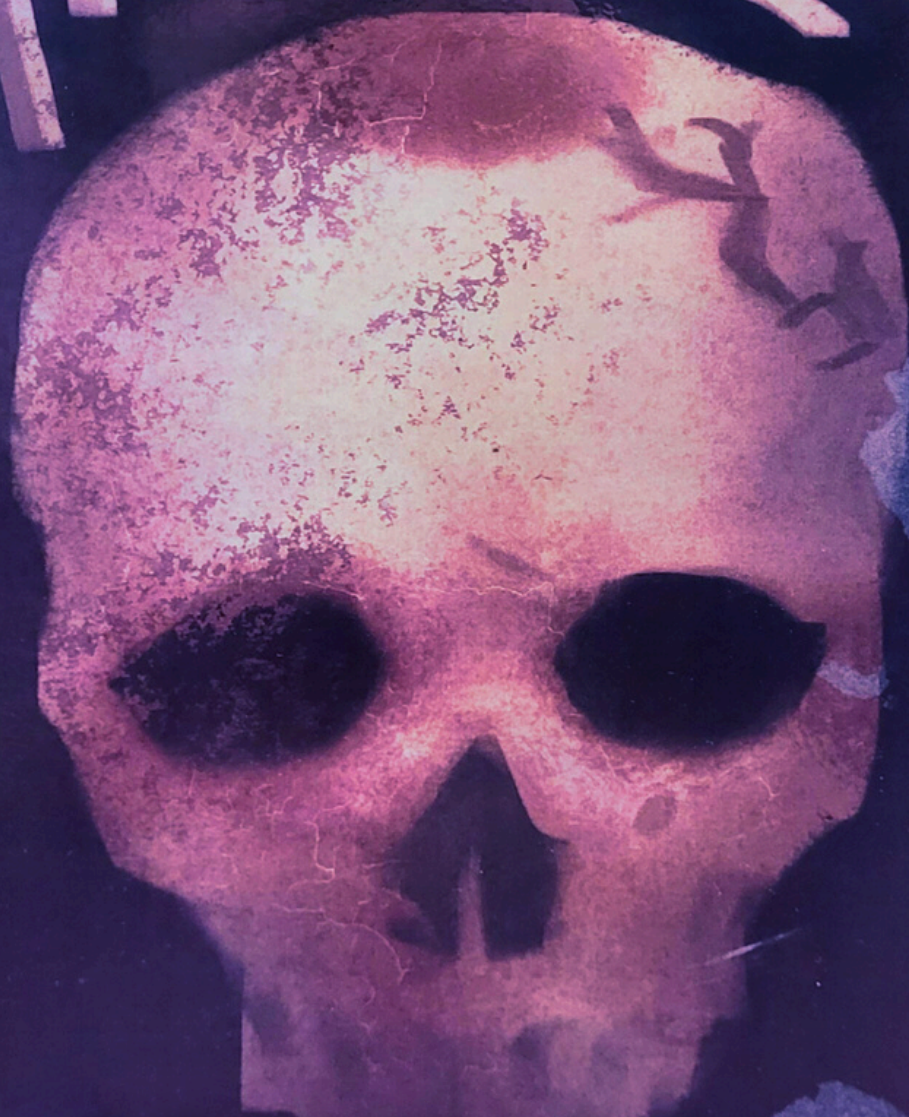

Your work can count towards NCEA if applicable.

## 1 Design a poster

Poster for a Shakespeare production or film by your school or any theatre/film group.

It must include: the name of the play and all performance details eg time, date, performed by, ticket prices, where to book, venue.

These must be clearly visible.

## 2 Present on A3 or A4 paper or light card and send in an appropriate size envelope folder or tube

## 3 Write an accompanying rationale of approximately 400 words describing:

- a brief outline of the style in which the play is being performed.
- why you are using the reflected style in your poster.
- the target audience to whom you are directing the design.

## 5 Enclose a prepaid envelope or tube with a courier sticker and return-to-sender address for returning the original of your entry

### CRITERIA

Any students at secondary school, home schooled, or community groups from Year 7-13, under 20 years of age are eligible to enter

All spelling must be accurate

Entrants must be a Friend of SGCNZ either through their school, home school cluster OR community groups, OR individually

The SGCNZ/ Adam Foundation Shakespeare Static Image Competition and the SGCNZ/ Adam Foundation Shakespeare Poster Competition are two separate Competitions.

Both can be entered at the same time with appropriate different designs and inclusions

### PRIZES

NB: The value of the prizes may vary depending on the entries and the judges' decisions. A first, second and third place winner will be chosen.



Prize winners will be announced at SGCNZ's VUW National Shakespeare Festival Award Ceremony at 7.00pm, 31 May 2026 at the St James Theatre in Wellington.

The finalists will have a chance to attend workshops at SGCNZ VUW National Festival free-of-charge on 29 May in Wellington.

The winning designs will be displayed at the National Festival and might be displayed in Shakespeare's Globe Exhibition, London for 6 weeks and in other locations in NZ.
