Calling choreographers and dancers of any style!

As part of its 30th celebratory year, Shakespeare Globe Centre NZ is providing the opportunity of taking this year's *Dance Nimble Soles* onto the stage of the Lower Hutt Little Theatre on 24 June.

Criteria:

- Create a Shakespeare-inspired 3-10 minute dance item of any genre, culture, ethnicity or type
- Casts may have from 2- 40 performers - in addition to dancers, these may include actors, singers, musicians
- There are no age limits
- The music must be original, out of copyright, or from the APRA/Creative Commons/Free Music Archives. Live musicians are welcome.
- Opportunities are available to be linked with finalists of the SGCNZ/Morrison Music Trust Shakespeare Music Competition.
- The presentation is simplistic
- Staging should be minimal – there will be a only a 2 minute set up and strike time
- A general stage lighting wash will be available
- Spoken words may be incorporated, though it is first and foremost a dance work
- Write up to 50 words suitable for the programme to describe how your item was inspired by and reflects the specific Shakespeare play and/or characters you have chosen
- Entry Fee : \$10 per person or SGCNZ Group Friends Membership \$110
- Registration Form must be submitted by 13 June 2021 to sgcnz@sgcnz.org.nz

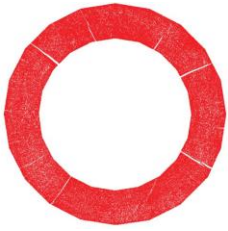
