Compositions may be no longer than 3 minutes

Compositions can be inspired by any Shakespeare play

Any students at secondary school, home schooled, or community groups from Year 7-13, under 20 years of age are eligible to enter

All spelling must be accurate

Entrants must be a Friend of SGCNZ either through their school, home school cluster OR community groups, OR individually

A first, second and third place winner will be chosen for Category A and Category B each. A Surpreme Winner will be chosen and receive further prizes

NB: The value of the prizes may vary depending on the entries and the judges decisions.

Prize winners will be announced at SGCNZ's National University of Otago Sheilah Winn Shakespeare Festival Award Ceremony at 7.00pm, Sunday 4 June 2023 at the St James Theatre in Wellington.

The finalists may attend workshops at SGCNZ National UOSWSF free-of-charge on Friday 2 June in Wellington.

The Supreme Winner, or if not available, another winner will be offered the position of Student Composer at SGCNZ's National Shakespeare Schools Production, 24 September – 2 October 2023 in Wellington and also be considered for selection as a member of the SGCNZ YSC 2024 travelling to the Globe in London.
